

Update for LBS Service Providers

As you know, the LearningHUB is part of the continuum of programs and services of The Centres for Employment & Learning of the Avon Maitland District School Board. One of our core values is Learner Centred Service Delivery and we encourage learners to “Maximize Your Potential”! We know that learners who are successful will be motivated to continue to succeed. At the LearningHUB we want to ensure that we are supporting learners who are demonstrating progress and focused on the attainment of their goals.

Historically, close to 20% of learners who register with the LearningHUB do not complete their learner plan. Congruent with the implementation of OALCF and focus on learner skill attainment, and with our values, we are now requiring that LearningHUB learners enrolled in Independent Study /Short Courses (aka Asynchronous learning) commit a minimum of 3 hours/week to working online. There is now an increased emphasis on goal setting activities and time management, as well as an assessment of online readiness and computer skills, during the registration and intake process of Asynchronous learners.

There is also now a Consent to Disclose agreement on the registration form, and more changes may occur as we prepare to collect the information required for EOIS CaMS.

Continuous improvement is the way that we do business. New LearningHUB initiatives include the following:

- Learner Tutorials following specific task-based learning;
- Learning packages that are aligned to OALCF goal paths;
- Digital Technology tasks featuring the LearningHUB;
- Development of OALCF-focussed curriculum;
- More independent study curriculum and assessment options.
